### JOINT SPECIALTY FELLOWSHIP EXAMINATION IN ORTHOPAEDIC SURGERY

The Hong Kong College of Orthopaedic Surgeons and the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh will conduct a Joint Specialty Fellowship Examination in **Orthopaedic Surgery** as detailed below:

**Written Examination: 15 October 2025 (Wednesday)**, 120 Multiple Choice Questions, 3 hours

Venue: Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Jockey Club Building

*(If Black Rainstorm Warning or Typhoon Signal No. 8 or above is issued, the examination will be postponed.)*

**Clinical Examination: 26 October 2025 (Sunday)**, 2 sessions: Long case in the morning and short case in the afternoon

Venue: North District Hospital

*(In case of unpredictable situation render clinical examination impossible to take place in hospital, the clinical examination will be replaced by 2 sessions of 'Clinical Scenario Viva Examination')*

**Vivas Examination: 27-28 October 2025 (Monday & Tuesday)**, Two (2) viva sessions in Day 1, Two (2) viva sessions in Day 2 (30 min each)

Venue: Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Jockey Club Building

Registered higher trainees of the Hong Kong College of Orthopaedic Surgeons who have completed by the time of the examination a minimum of three and a half year of accredited training rotations in Orthopaedics are eligible to apply to sit for this Examination.

- The **CLOSING DATE** for applications of the Examination is **MONDAY 30 JUNE 2025**.
- Successful applicants will be notified within 2 months after the closure of application.
- The fee for this Examination is HK\$40,000.
- **Please send the application form together with a crossed cheque in amount of HK\$40,000 payable to "THE HONG KONG COLLEGE OF ORTHOPAEDIC SURGEONS" and attention to Chief Censor on or before the closing date.**
