## **HKCOS Rehabilitation Exit Assessment 2017**

The Orthopaedic Rehabilitation Subspecialty Board would hold its 10<sup>th</sup> Exit Assessment on 13 October 2017 (Friday).

During the Assessment, our Assessor would discuss and evaluate candidates in the following aspects related to their capacity in providing quality service to patients in rehabilitation facilities:

- 1. Knowledge and Experience in Rehabilitation as presented in the candidates' published paper(s).
- 2. Knowledge and Experience in providing service to patients in his/her respective Rehabilitation Training Centre.
- 3. Ability for Quality Assurance in Rehabilitation Service: setting of rehabilitation goals for individual patients, outcome assessment and performance auditing.

Trainees who wish to take part in the Exit Assessment need to fill in the attached application form and mail it together with:

- 1. A copy of the trainees' paper in Rehabilitation accepted or published before 12 September 2017.
- 2. A cheque of HKD10,000 payable to "The Hong Kong College of Orthopaedic Surgeons" as the assessment fee.

The deadline for application would be **<u>12 September 2017</u>**.

Please be reminded that this Exit Assessment is the **last attempt** in accordance with the training curriculum version 2004 for trainees admitted before 1 July 2016. Therefore, those trainees who will not take part in the Exit Assessment this year will fall into the NEW training curriculum (version 2016) and will be required to submit an annual training fee to continue the trainee status. Please return the completed reply slip together with a cheque of HKD2,000 payable to "The Hong Kong College of Orthopaedic Surgeons" for annual training fee <u>on or before 30 June 2017</u>. Late submissions may result in delay of training for a year. The first Exit Assessment based on the new training curriculum (version 2016) will be conducted in 2018.
