This monograph attempts to detail the development of Orthopaedics in Hong Kong since Prof AR Hodgson came to Hong Kong in 1951. Interesting personal stories were unfolded in the section of Remembrances and Thoughts, whereas an in-depth understanding of some of our outstanding peers was captured in a series of Interviews.
